FOR the purpose of exempting Frederick County from certain soil erosion and sediment control standards; requiring completion of certain stabilization measures within certain periods of time; eliminating a certain limit on a certain area to be graded; eliminating a certain mapping requirement; and generally relating to soil erosion and sediment control standards in Frederick County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (b) (1) [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 19 SUBSECTION, EACH county or municipality shall adopt grading and building 20 ordinances necessary to carry out the provisions of this subtitle, with the assistance of 21 the Department of the Environment and the appropriate soil conservation district.

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FOLLOWING 1 **(I)** INITIAL SOIL OR DISTURBANCE $\mathbf{2}$ REDISTURBANCE, PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STABILIZATION SHALL BE 3 **COMPLETED WITHIN:** 4 SEVEN CALENDAR DAYS FOR THE SURFACE OF 1. $\mathbf{5}$ ALL PERIMETER CONTROLS, DIKES, SWALES, DITCHES, PERIMETER SLOPES, 6 AND ALL SLOPES GREATER THAN THREE HORIZONTAL TO ONE VERTICAL; AND 72. 14 CALENDAR DAYS FOR ALL OTHER DISTURBED 8 **OR GRADED AREAS;** 9 THERE IS NO LIMIT ON THE MAXIMUM CONTIGUOUS **(II)** AREA ALLOWED TO BE GRADED AT A GIVEN TIME; AND 10 11 (III) THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO MAP THE LOCATION OF 12A SITE'S NATURAL RESOURCES, STEEP SLOPES, HIGHLY ERODIBLE SOILS, OR 13**VEGETATIVE BUFFER STRIPS.** 14SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
