- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- THIS SECTION APPLIES TO APPOINTING AUTHORITIES FOR 5 (A)
- POSITIONS IN THE JUDICIAL, LEGISLATIVE, AND EXECUTIVE BRANCHES OF 6
- STATE GOVERNMENT, EXCEPT A POSITION IN THE STATE PERSONNEL 7
- 8 MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.
- 9 (B) AN APPOINTING AUTHORITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL
- DEVELOP A HIRING PREFERENCE FOR APPLICANTS WHO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY 10
