2 (a) The Secretary shall solicit grant proposals to implement the Program 3 priorities approved by the Governor and the General Assembly under § 10–603(a) of 4 this subtitle.

5 (b) With the advice of the [Council] **COMMISSION**, the Secretary shall 6 award grants funded in accordance with the approved Program priorities.

7 (c) The Secretary shall provide for the evaluation, by recognized authorities 8 in the field of services to seniors, of the programs funded by the grants.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2013.
