- 20 (a) (2) "Council" means the Maryland Youth Advisory Council.

(e) (1) The term of a youth member of the Council is 1 year, from
September 1 through August 30 of the following year.

1 (2) A youth member who is appointed or selected after a term has 2 begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed or selected 3 and qualifies.

(3) [A youth member may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

5 (4)] The member from the Senate and the member from the House 6 serve, respectively, at the pleasure of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of 7 the House.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2013.
