12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Environment

IN THIS SECTION, "HYDRAULIC FRACTURING" MEANS A 16 **(**A**)** (1) DRILLING TECHNIQUE THAT EXPANDS EXISTING FRACTURES OR CREATES NEW 17 18 FRACTURES IN ROCK BY INJECTING FLUIDS, OFTEN A MIXTURE OF WATER AND 19CHEMICALS, SAND, OR OTHER SUBSTANCES, AND OFTEN UNDER PRESSURE, 20 INTO OR UNDERNEATH THE SURFACE OF THE ROCK FOR PURPOSES THAT 21INCLUDE WELL DRILLING AND THE EXPLORATION OR PRODUCTION OF NATURAL 22GAS.
