4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain health occupations boards within the 5 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to establish a certain electronic 6 system for the purpose of distributing certain licenses, permits, certifications, or 7 registrations; requiring the system to meet certain requirements; requiring 8 certain boards to discontinue sending by first-class mail certain renewal notices 9 and a renewed license, permit, certificate, or registration; requiring certain boards to send by electronic means certain renewal notices and a renewed 10 license, permit, certification, or registration; requiring certain boards to 11 12 continue to send by first-class mail an initial license, permit, certification, or 13 registration; requiring certain health occupations boards to investigate certain 14 violations of law; providing immunity from liability for certain persons who 15 provide certain information to certain health occupations boards or participate 16 in certain activities; authorizing certain health occupations boards to send a 17 certain notice by electronic means or first-class mail; providing that certain 18 individuals who act in good faith and within the scope of jurisdiction of certain 19 boards are not civilly liable for providing certain information or for participating 20 in certain activities; defining certain terms; altering certain definitions; making 21 certain conforming and stylistic changes; and generally relating to the health 22 occupations boards and license renewal, investigation of alleged violations, and 23 immunity from liability.
