# A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Allegany County – Video Lottery Terminals – Distribution of Proceeds

- FOR the purpose of altering a certain requirement for the distribution of certain
   proceeds from video lottery terminals at a video lottery facility in Allegany
   County; and generally relating to proceeds from video lottery terminals at a
   video lottery facility in Allegany County.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article State Government
- 20 9–1A–27.

(a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section and §
9-1A-26(a)(3) of this subtitle, on a properly approved transmittal prepared by the
Commission, the Comptroller shall pay the following amounts from the proceeds of
video lottery terminals at each video lottery facility:

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$\frac{1}{2}$	(1) (i) on or before March 31, 2015, 2% to the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency for costs as defined in § 9–1A–01 of this subtitle; and
$\frac{3}{4}$	(ii) beginning April 1, 2015, 1% to the State Lottery and Gaming Control Agency for costs as defined in § 9–1A–01 of this subtitle;
5 6 7	(2) to the video lottery operation licensee, the percentage stated in the accepted application for the location, not to exceed, except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, 33%;
8 9	(3) 5.5% in local impact grants, in accordance with § 9–1A–31 of this subtitle;
10 11	(4) 7% to the Purse Dedication Account established under § 9–1A–28 of this subtitle, not to exceed a total of \$100,000,000 to the Account annually;
$12 \\ 13 \\ 14$	(5) (i) until the issuance of a video lottery operation license in Baltimore City, 1.75% to the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account established under § 9–1A–29 of this subtitle and distributed in accordance with that section; and
$15 \\ 16 \\ 17 \\ 18$	(ii) on or after the issuance of a video lottery operation license in Baltimore City, 1% to the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account established under § $9-1A-29$ of this subtitle and distributed in accordance with that section, not to exceed a total of \$20,000,000 to the Account annually;
19 20	(6) 1.5% to the Small, Minority, and Women–Owned Businesses Account established under § 9–1A–35 of this subtitle;
21 22 23	(7) (i) except as provided in item (ii) of this item, 6% to the video lottery operation licensee if the video lottery operation licensee owns or leases each video lottery terminal device and the associated equipment and software; and
$\begin{array}{c} 24 \\ 25 \end{array}$	(ii) 8% to the video lottery operation licensee in Anne Arundel County;
26 27 28	(8) beginning after the issuance of a video lottery operation license for a video lottery facility in Prince George's County, 8% to the video lottery operation licensee in Anne Arundel County and 7% to the licensee in Baltimore City for:
29 30	(i) marketing, advertising, and promotional costs required under § 9–1A–23 of this subtitle; and
31	(ii) capital improvements at the video lottery facilities; and
32 33	(9) the remainder to the Education Trust Fund established under § 9–1A–30 of this subtitle.

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1 (b) (2) [(i) After 1 year of operations at a video lottery facility in 2 Allegany County, the percentage in subsection (c)(1)(ii) of this section is equal to 50%, 3 provided that each year an amount equivalent to 0.5% of the proceeds from video 4 lottery terminals at the video lottery facility is spent on capital improvements at the 5 video lottery facility; or

6 (ii) after] **AFTER** the first 10 years of operations at a video 7 lottery facility in Allegany County, the percentage:

8 [1.] (I) in subsection (a)(2) of this section is equal to 43% 9 provided that each year an amount equivalent to 2.5% of the proceeds from video 10 lottery terminals at the video lottery facility is spent on capital improvements at the 11 video lottery facility; and

12 [2.] (II) in subsection (a)(1) of this section is equal to 2%.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October 1, 2013.
