(a) (1) This section applies only to Allegany County, Carroll County, Cecil
County, Dorchester County, Frederick County, Harford County, Kent County,
Somerset County, Wicomico County, and Worcester County.

5 (2) Except as modified by this section, the provisions of § 7–302 of this 6 subtitle apply to this section.

7 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the 8 commanding officer may designate 12 members of a fire company to be appointed as 9 deputy sheriffs.

10 (2) In Cecil County AND HARFORD COUNTY, the commanding officer 11 may designate 20 members of a fire company to be appointed as deputy sheriffs.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2013.
