- 5 FOR the purpose of requiring that the Upper Shore Community Mental Health Center 6 be maintained under the direction of the Mental Hygiene Administration: 7 declaring the intent of the General Assembly for the State to reopen the Center 8 and the Administration to maintain the Center in accordance with certain 9 provisions of law; and generally relating to the Mental Hygiene Administration 10 and the reopening and maintenance of the Upper Shore Community Mental Health Center establishing the Task Force to Evaluate Mental Health Care 11 Delivery on the Eastern Shore; providing for the composition, cochairs, and 12 staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from 13 receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain 14 expenses; requiring the Task Force to evaluate certain matters; requiring the 15 Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and 16 17 certain legislative committees on or before a certain date; providing for the 18 termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Evaluate Mental Health Care Delivery on the Eastern Shore. 19

12	(1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but
13 14	(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
15 16	(f) The Task Force shall evaluate the state of mental health care delivery on the Eastern Shore, including:
17 18	(1) whether and to what extent patients with mental illness are being referred to out-of-state mental health facilities;
19	(2) the adequacy of the mental health care workforce;
20 21	(3) the impact the closure of the Upper Shore Community Mental Health Center has had on communities in the former service area of the Center;
22 23	(4) the feasibility of reopening the Upper Shore Community Mental Health Center;
24 25	(5) the barriers to accessibility of mental health services on the Eastern Shore;
26 27	(6) the volume of admissions and mix of forensic and nonforensic patients in State—run psychiatric facilities; and
28 29	(7) whether there is sufficient capacity for non-forensic patients in State-run psychiatric facilities.
30 31	(g) On or before December 31, 2013, the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State

- 1 <u>Government Article, the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and</u> 2 <u>Government Operations Committee.</u>
- SECTION 3. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October June 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of 8 months and, at the end of January 31, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
- 6 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
