A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sunday Sales**

3 FOR the purpose of making inapplicable in Calvert County the prohibition against a
4 holder of a Class B or Class C license from selling alcoholic beverages at a bar or
5 counter on Sunday; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales in
6 Calvert County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages
9 Section 11–403(a)(1)
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

15 11–403.

16 (a) (1) **(I) THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY IN CALVERT**
17 **COUNTY.**

18 **(II)** A retail dealer holding a Class B or C license may not sell
19 any alcoholic beverage at a bar or counter on Sunday.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 July 1, 2013.
