10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)							
Meade High School is the largest public school in Anne Arundel County serving 2500+ students. Over 800 of those students participate in athletics. our athletic mission statement is listed below.							

Interscholastic athletics can be a fun, rewarding, and memorable part of the high school experience. While academics offer the primary source for formal education, athletics can contribute to the total value of that education in many different ways. Building upon the concepts of teamwork, fair play, sportsmanship, and self-esteem, the athletic experience can help to provide for a well rounded educational experience. Athletic participation is a privilege and not a right. To those who strive to succeed in the classroom comes the privilege to compete outside of it.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Meade High School is the only public high school in Anne Arundel County that does not have running water and rest rooms at their stadium. The purpose of this project is to construct a building that will have men's and women's rest rooms, concessions, two ticket booths and a storage area. This would allow us to vacate our current concession stand (which is partially condemned) and move it to a much better location. Not only is the current concession area we have outdated, it's also too small and causes crowd control problems when we have events with large crowds.

Since the installation of a turf field at our stadium, we now share our stadium with Recreation and Parks. This building would allow their players, parents, and spectators to have access to rest room facilities as well.

Currently, our ticket booth is a shed without electricity. By moving our ticket booths into this building, we will have electricity and access into our stadium will become easier, especially for visitors. Our ticket takers will have an easier time sorting and counting money with proper lighting.
