**Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Salary of Part-Time Liquor
Inspectors
PG 316-13**

This bill makes technical corrections to Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages to clarify that the annual salary of a part-time liquor inspector in Prince George’s County is \$10,900.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2013.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The bill is corrective and clarifying in nature and will not affect Prince George’s County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law/Background: Alcoholic beverages license inspections in Prince George’s County are performed by part-time inspectors under the supervision of a Chief Inspector and two deputies. Under Article 2B, § 15-112 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the annual salary of each part-time inspector is incorrectly stated to be at least \$9,976. An annual salary of \$10,900 for alcoholic beverages inspectors was established within Chapter 156 of 2010.
