<u>AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1014</u> (Third Reading File Bill)

On page 1, strike beginning with "<u>providing</u>" in line 7 down through "liability" in line 10 and substitute "<u>providing that certain nurses and certain school personnel</u> <u>may not be held personally liable for certain acts or omissions</u>".

On page 2, in line 21, strike "<u>SIGNS AND</u>"; strike beginning with "<u>BY</u>" in line 22 down through "<u>ANAPHYLAXIS</u>" in line 25; strike beginning with the comma in line 29 down through "<u>TO</u>" in line 30; in line 30, strike the comma; and in line 31, after the semicolon, insert "<u>AND</u>".

On page 3, in line 4, strike "<u>; AND</u>" and substitute a period; strike in their entirety lines 5 through 13, inclusive; and after line 13, insert:

"(D) EXCEPT FOR ANY WILLFUL OR GROSSLY NEGLIGENT ACT, A SCHOOL NURSE OR OTHER SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO RESPOND IN GOOD FAITH TO THE ANAPHYLACTIC REACTION OF A CHILD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE HELD PERSONALLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACT OR OMISSION IN THE COURSE OF RESPONDING TO THE REACTION.".

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 33 on page 4 through line 3 on page 5, inclusive.

On page 5, after line 3, insert:

"(D) EXCEPT FOR ANY WILLFUL OR GROSSLY NEGLIGENT ACT, SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO RESPOND IN GOOD FAITH TO THE ANAPHYLACTIC REACTION OF A CHILD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE HELD
