# <u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 235</u> (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "requiring" in line 3 down through "closure" in line 6 and substitute "prohibiting the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City or a court from staying an order to revoke an alcoholic beverages license until a certain number of days after a license is revoked; providing that a person whose license revocation by the Board is subsequently overturned on appeal is entitled to reimbursement for lost wages as a result of a certain prohibition; prohibiting a person whose license has been revoked by the Board from giving, serving, dispensing, keeping, or allowing to be consumed any alcoholic beverages until certain circumstances occur".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 7, insert:

"<u>BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u> <u>Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages</u> <u>Section 16-101(c)</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2011 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)";

and after line 15, insert:

"<u>16–101.</u>

(c) (1) [Upon] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ON the filing of an appeal, the local licensing board may stay its order until the final determination thereof.

# (2) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OR A COURT MAY NOT STAY AN ORDER TO REVOKE A LICENSE PENDING JUDICIAL REVIEW UNTIL 45 DAYS AFTER THE LICENSE IS REVOKED.

# AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 17 through 23, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>A PERSON WHOSE LICENSE HAS BEEN REVOKED BY THE BOARD OF</u> <u>LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR BALTIMORE CITY MAY NOT GIVE,</u> <u>SERVE, DISPENSE, KEEP, OR ALLOW TO BE CONSUMED ANY ALCOHOLIC</u> <u>BEVERAGES UNTIL A STAY IS GRANTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 16-101(C) OF</u> <u>THIS SUBTITLE OR THE REVOCATION IS REVERSED ON APPEAL.</u>".
