AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 226, AS AMENDED
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2 of the bill, in line 17, after “investors;” insert “providing that, when evaluating and comparing a proposed offshore wind project, the Commission may not disqualify a bidder, an offeror, or a subcontractor because the bidder, offeror, or subcontractor is not a signatory to a certain labor union agreement or require a bidder, an offeror, or a subcontractor to employ only individuals hired through a union;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 17 and 18 of the bill, strike beginning with “**THE**” in line 30 on page 17 through “**(X)**” in line 9 on page 18.

On page 18 of the bill, in line 13, strike “**(XI)**” and substitute “**(IX)**”.

On page 2 of the Finance Committee Amendments (HB0226/567175/1), in line 3 of Amendment No. 2, strike “**(XII)**” and substitute “**(X)**”; and in lines 6 and 7, strike “**(XIII)**” and “**(XIV)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(XI)**” and “**(XII)**”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 19 of the bill, after line 16, insert:

“(5) IN EVALUATING AND COMPARING A PROPOSED OFFSHORE WIND PROJECT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION MAY NOT:

(I) DISQUALIFY A BIDDER, AN OFFEROR, OR A SUBCONTRACTOR BECAUSE THE BIDDER, OFFEROR, OR SUBCONTRACTOR IS
