AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 139
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate O’Donnell” and substitute “Delegates O’Donnell and Krebs”; in line 2, strike “Training for Public”; in the same line, after “Act” insert “- Training for Public Bodies”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “body;” in line 5; in lines 6, 8, 9, and 11, in each instance, strike “online”; in line 8, after “the” insert “State Open Meetings Law Compliance”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 10 down through “training;” in line 11; in line 11, strike “training on the requirements of”; in line 12, after “Act” insert “and training for public bodies”; and in line 13, strike “with” and substitute “without”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 3, strike “**(1)**”; in lines 5, 6, and 7, in each instance, strike the bracket; in the same lines, strike “**(I)**”, “**(II)**”, and “**(III)**”, respectively; strike beginning with “; AND” in line 7 down through “**BODY**” in line 10; strike beginning with “**INDIVIDUALS**” in line 13 down through “**MEMBERS**” in line 14 and substitute “**AT LEAST ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN EMPLOYEE, AN OFFICER, OR A MEMBER**”; in line 14, strike “**ONLINE**”; and strike in their entirety lines 18 through 28, inclusive, and substitute:

“(B) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER BEING DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL COMPLETE:

(1) AN ONLINE CLASS ON THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW OFFERED BY THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND’S INSTITUTE FOR GOVERNMENTAL SERVICE AND RESEARCH; OR

(Over)

(2) A CLASS ON THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW OFFERED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES OR THE MARYLAND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE THROUGH THE ACADEMY FOR EXCELLENCE IN LOCAL GOVERNANCE.

On page 3, in line 3, strike “online”.
