AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 134  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after “Administration)” insert “and Senators Middleton, Astle, Feldman, Kelley, Klausmeier, Mathias, and Pugh”; in line 9, strike “is not enrolled” and substitute “has not applied for enrollment”; and in line 20, after “Assembly;” insert “authorizing the Board to extend the date for closing certain enrollment under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to notify certain legislative committees and the Department of Legislative Services of the extension within a certain time period; providing for the termination of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “UNLESS” in line 27 down through the comma in line 29.

On page 4, in line 8, strike “IS NOT ENROLLED” and substitute “HAS NOT APPLIED FOR ENROLLMENT”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, after line 20, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Board of Directors for the Maryland Health Insurance Plan:

(1) may extend the date established under § 14-502(f)(1)(ii) of the Insurance Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, for closing enrollment in the Maryland Health Insurance Plan to bridge eligible individuals if the Board determines that bridge eligible individuals continue to be unsuccessful in enrolling in coverage through the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange; and

(Over)

(2) shall notify the Senate Finance Committee, the House Health and Government Operations Committee, the Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly, and the Department of Legislative Services of the extension within 15 days after it is approved.”;

and in line 21, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, in line 25, after the period insert “It shall remain effective through June 30, 2015, and, at the end of June 30, 2015, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
