AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1087

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Maximum Period of Idling – Repeal" and substitute "Prohibition Against Unattended Motor Vehicle - Exception"; strike beginning with "repealing" in line 3 down through "time" in line 6 and substitute "creating an exception to the prohibition against leaving an unattended motor vehicle under certain circumstances for a motor vehicle that operates unattended for a certain period of time under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the prohibition against unattended motor vehicles"; in line 9, strike "22-402(c)" and substitute "21-1101"; and after line 11, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

<u>Article - Transportation</u>

Section 22-402(c)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2012 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 14, insert:

"21–1101.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person driving or otherwise in charge of a motor vehicle may not leave it unattended until the engine is stopped, the ignition locked, the key removed, and the brake effectively set.
- (b) A person driving or otherwise in charge of a motor vehicle may not leave the motor vehicle unattended until, if the vehicle is on a grade, the front wheels are turned to the curb or side of the highway.

- (c) When a cat or dog is left in the unattended vehicle of an on-duty law enforcement officer or an animal control officer, the provisions of subsection (a) of this section do not apply to the law enforcement officer or the animal control officer.
- (2) SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A
 PERSON WHO ALLOWS A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS LOCKED OR IS ON PRIVATE
 PROPERTY NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC TO OPERATE UNATTENDED FOR UP TO 5
 CONSECUTIVE MINUTES WHEN THE VEHICLE IS NOT IN MOTION.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in lines 4, 14, and 17, in each instance, strike the bracket; and in line 17, strike "(4)".
