5 (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT ~~NATIVE~~
6 ~~AMERICANS~~ AMERICAN INDIANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR
7 ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM NOVEMBER AS ~~NATIVE AMERICAN~~ AMERICAN
8 INDIAN HERITAGE MONTH.

9 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL
10 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE ~~NATIVE AMERICAN~~ AMERICAN INDIAN HERITAGE
11 MONTH PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND
12 ACTIVITIES.
