A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Maryland Seal of Biliteracy Act – Establishment**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Seal of Biliteracy Program; providing
4 for the purpose of the Program; providing that participation in the Program by a
5 local school system is voluntary; providing that beginning with a certain
6 graduating class, certain students shall receive a certain seal under certain
7 circumstances; requiring the State Board of Education to establish certain
8 criteria and requirements by a certain date; requiring the State Board to
9 provide certain information regarding the Program to certain local school
10 systems by a certain date; requiring certain local school systems to maintain
11 certain records; requiring certain local school systems to affix a certain seal to
12 certain academic documents under certain circumstances; requiring the State
13 Board to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally
14 relating to the Maryland Seal of Biliteracy Program.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Education**

23 **7–208.**

1 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE**
2 **MEANINGS INDICATED.**

3 **(2) “ELIGIBLE STUDENT” MEANS A STUDENT WHO ATTENDS A**
4 **PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL THAT PARTICIPATES IN THE MARYLAND SEAL OF**
5 **BILITERACY PROGRAM.**

6 **(3) (I) “FOREIGN LANGUAGE” MEANS A LANGUAGE OTHER**
7 **THAN ENGLISH.**

8 **(II) “FOREIGN LANGUAGE” INCLUDES AMERICAN SIGN**
9 **LANGUAGE.**

10 **(4) “PROGRAM” MEANS THE MARYLAND SEAL OF BILITERACY**
11 **PROGRAM.**

12 **(B) THERE IS A MARYLAND SEAL OF BILITERACY PROGRAM UNDER**
13 **THIS SECTION THAT RECOGNIZES PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES IN THE**
14 **STATE WHO HAVE ATTAINED PROFICIENCY IN SPEAKING, READING, AND**
15 **WRITING IN ONE OR MORE LANGUAGES IN ADDITION TO ENGLISH.**

16 **(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROMOTE LINGUISTIC**
17 **PROFICIENCY AND CULTURAL LITERACY IN ONE OR MORE LANGUAGES IN**
18 **ADDITION TO ENGLISH AND TO PROVIDE RECOGNITION OF THE ATTAINMENT OF**
19 **THOSE SKILLS BY AFFIXING A SEAL OF BILITERACY TO THE STUDENT’S**
20 **DIPLOMA OR TRANSCRIPT AT GRADUATION.**

21 **(D) (1) PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM BY A LOCAL SCHOOL**
22 **SYSTEM IS VOLUNTARY.**

23 **(2) IF A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM CHOOSES TO PARTICIPATE IN**
24 **THE PROGRAM, AN INDIVIDUAL SCHOOL MAY NOT OPT OUT OF PARTICIPATION**
25 **IN THE PROGRAM.**

26 **(E) (1) BEGINNING WITH THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 2015, EACH**
27 **ELIGIBLE STUDENT WHO MEETS THE CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS**
28 **ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (F)(1)**
29 **OF THIS SECTION SHALL RECEIVE A SEAL OF BILITERACY.**

30 **(2) A SEAL OF BILITERACY SHALL BE AFFIXED TO THE**
31 **STUDENT’S DIPLOMA OR TRANSCRIPT AT GRADUATION.**

32 **(F) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2014, THE STATE BOARD SHALL:**

1 **(1) ESTABLISH CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS A STUDENT MUST**
2 **MEET TO RECEIVE A SEAL OF BILITERACY; AND**

3 **(2) PROVIDE INFORMATION TO EACH LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM**
4 **REGARDING HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN AND HOW TO IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM.**

5 **(G) A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM SHALL:**

6 **(1) MAINTAIN RECORDS NECESSARY FOR DETERMINING A**
7 **STUDENT'S ELIGIBILITY FOR A SEAL OF BILITERACY; AND**

8 **(2) AFFIX A SEAL OF BILITERACY TO THE DIPLOMA OR**
9 **TRANSCRIPT OF EVERY ELIGIBLE STUDENT MEETING THE CRITERIA AND**
10 **REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH**
11 **SUBSECTION (F)(1) OF THIS SECTION.**

12 **(H) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT**
13 **THIS SECTION.**

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2014.
