4 5	(II) PROVIDES SERVICES TO AN INDIVIDUAL BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL IS ADMITTED TO A HOSPITAL.
$6 \\ 7$	(4) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS AN AGENCY THAT IS LISTED IN § 3–101(E) OF THIS TITLE.
8 9 10 11	(B) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY'S VEHICLE USED FOR PATROL BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS A FIRST RESPONDER AND TRAINED IN THE OPERATION AND USE OF AN AED SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH AN AED.
