The 2526 license may not be issued for any drugstore. 27 (h) (1) This subsection applies only to Carroll County. 28 The privileges conferred by a Class D beer and light wine license

may be exercised from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. on Sunday.

- 2 (a) (1) A Class A beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the license issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The license authorizes the holder to keep for sale and to sell all alcoholic beverages at retail, in any quantity, at the place described in the license. The licensee shall deliver the alcoholic beverages in a sealed package or container and the package or container
- 7 may not be opened nor its contents consumed on the premises where sold.
- 9 (1) From July 1, 2014, To June 30, 2017, \$850; AND

In Carroll County the annual license fee is [\$650]:

- 10 **(2) BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2017, \$1,000**.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
