3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Garrett County Salary Study
4 Commission to include a member appointed by the County Commissioners of
5 Garrett County; repealing obsolete language; and generally relating to the
6 Garrett County Salary Study Commission.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 The Public Local Laws of Garrett County
9 Section 32.41
10 Article 12 – Public Local Laws of Maryland
11 (2005 Edition and October 2013 Supplement, as amended)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 12 – Garrett County**

15 32.41.

16 (A) The Commission consists of 7 members.

17 (B) The Commission shall be comprised as follows:

1 (1) One member from the Republican Central Committee of Garrett
2 County;

3 (2) One member from the Democrat Central Committee of Garrett
4 County;

5 (3) One member from the Garrett County Mayors Association;

6 (4) One member from the Chamber of Commerce of Garrett County;

7 (5) One member from the Farm Bureau of Garrett County;

8 (6) One member from the [Garrett County Advisory Committee on
9 Education;

10 (7) One member from the] Garrett County Volunteer Firemen's
11 Association, Inc.; AND

12 **(7) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.**

13 (C) Each group listed in division (B) of this section shall appoint the member
14 who represents the group on the Commission.

15 (D) The County Commissioners may provide compensation or reimbursement
16 for expenses for the members of the Commission.

17 (E) From among its members, the Commission shall elect a Chairperson.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2014.
