VEHICLE MAY BE STORED INSIDE THE VEHICLE IN A MANNER THAT MAKES THE PLATE EASILY ACCESSIBLE FOR VERIFICATION UNDER SUBSECTION (I) OF THIS SECTION.

4 (i) (1) It is the duty of every police officer to report to the Administration 5 all vehicles operated in violation of this section.

6 (2) The Administration shall verify whether the owner of a reported 7 vehicle has complied with this section.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2014.
