## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Loyola University and The Johns Hopkins University Police**  
3 **Forces**

4 FOR the purpose of including a member of the police force of Loyola University and  
5 the police force of The Johns Hopkins University in the defined term “police  
6 officer” in connection with provisions of law relating to the authority to make  
7 arrests and to the Maryland Police Training Commission; and generally relating  
8 to the police forces of Loyola University and The Johns Hopkins University.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
8 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 law to make arrests and is:

13 (24) a member of the police force of the Hagerstown Community  
14 College; [or]

15 (25) an employee of the Warrant Apprehension Unit of the Division of  
16 Parole and Probation in the Department;

17 **(26) A MEMBER OF THE POLICE FORCE OF LOYOLA UNIVERSITY;**

19 **(27) A MEMBER OF THE POLICE FORCE OF THE JOHNS HOPKINS**  
20 **UNIVERSITY.**

23 (e) (1) “Police officer” means an individual who:

24 (i) is authorized to enforce the general criminal laws of the
