A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Anesthesia Services - Assignment of Billing Rights and Fees for Management Services - Prohibition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the billing rights for anesthesia services provided in a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ freestanding ambulatory care facility from being assigned to a person that has a 6 certain beneficial interest in the freestanding ambulatory care facility; 7 prohibiting a freestanding ambulatory care facility or a person that has a 8 certain beneficial interest in the freestanding ambulatory care facility from 9 charging, directly or indirectly, an anesthesia services provider a fee for management services; prohibiting a person, with the intent to retaliate, from 10 knowingly taking any action harmful to an individual for providing certain 11 12information to a law enforcement officer, the Department of Health and Mental 13 Hygiene, a health occupation board, or the Attorney General; establishing certain penalties for a violation of certain provisions of this Act; authorizing a 14disciplinary panel of the State Board of Physicians to take certain disciplinary 1516 action against a licensee if the licensee accepts an assignment of certain billing 17rights or charges a management services fee to certain practitioners in a 18 freestanding ambulatory care facility in which the licensee owns a beneficial 19interest; defining a certain term; and generally relating to anesthesia services 20and assignment of billing rights to and charging of management services fees by persons that have a beneficial interest in freestanding ambulatory care 2122facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF $\mathbf{5}$ MARYLAND, That Section(s) 1-307 of Article - Health Occupations of the Annotated 6 $\overline{7}$ Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 1–308. 8 SECTION 2. 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1(3)ASSISTANCE IN TRANSFERRING BILLING DOCUMENTATION TO2THE BILLING OFFICE OF THE ANESTHESIA SERVICES PROVIDER.

3 A PERSON, WITH THE INTENT TO RETALIATE, MAY NOT KNOWINGLY **(D)** TAKE ANY ACTION HARMFUL TO AN INDIVIDUAL, INCLUDING INTERFERENCE 4 $\mathbf{5}$ WITH THE LAWFUL EMPLOYMENT OR LIVELIHOOD OF THE INDIVIDUAL, FOR 6 PROVIDING TO A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, THE DEPARTMENT, A HEALTH 7 OCCUPATION BOARD, OR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ANY TRUTHFUL 8 INFORMATION RELATING TO THE COMMISSION OR POSSIBLE COMMISSION OF A 9 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.

10 (E) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 11 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING 12 \$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

14 (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14–405 of this subtitle, a 15 disciplinary panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the 16 disciplinary panel, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or 17 suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:

18 (15–A) ACCEPTS THE ASSIGNMENT OF BILLING RIGHTS FOR 19 ANESTHESIA SERVICES PROVIDED BY ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER 20 OR CHARGES, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, A FEE FOR MANAGEMENT SERVICES 21 TO ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER WHO PROVIDES ANESTHESIA 22 SERVICES IN A FREESTANDING AMBULATORY CARE FACILITY IN WHICH THE 23 LICENSEE OWNS A BENEFICIAL INTEREST, AS DEFINED IN § 1–301 OF THIS 24 ARTICLE;

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
