AN ACT concerning 1

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Farm Area Motor Vehicles - Registration and Authorized Use

- 3 FOR the purpose of increasing the radius from a farm within which a person may 4 operate on a highway a motor vehicle registered as a farm area motor vehicle; 5 requiring an applicant for registration of a farm area motor vehicle to submit 6 with the application certain documentation of active farming status; altering a certain definition; making this Act an emergency measure; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the registration and 9 authorized use of farm area motor vehicles.
