A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Property Tax Assessment Appeal Board – Member – Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the compensation of certain members of a property tax
4 assessment appeal board; and generally relating to property tax assessment
5 appeal boards.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Tax – Property**

19 3–101.

20 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

21 (c) “Board” means a property tax assessment appeal board.

1 (d) "Member" means a member or alternate member of a property tax
2 assessment appeal board.

4 (c) Each member of a board is entitled to:

5 (1) compensation at an hourly rate [as provided in the State budget]
6 **EQUAL TO \$40 PER HOUR**; and

7 (2) reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel
8 Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 July 1, 2014.
