2 (A) An appellate court may appoint the law clerks, stenographers, and other 3 full or part time employees it deems necessary.

### 4 (B) IF AN APPELLATE COURT CONTRACTS WITH A PRIVATE ENTITY FOR 5 STENOGRAPHY SERVICES, THE COURT SHALL REQUIRE THE ENTITY TO PROVIDE 6 AT LEAST 5% OF THE STENOGRAPHY SERVICES FREE OF CHARGE IN ORDER TO 7 ENSURE ACCESS TO COURT SERVICES BY INDIGENT CLIENTS.

9 Except as provided for the Circuit Court for Baltimore City in Subtitle 5A (a) 10 of this title, the judges of the circuit court for a county may employ the court administrators, assignment commissioners, auditors, masters, examiners, court 11 bailiffs, librarians. 12reporters. messengers, court criers, clerks. secretaries. 13stenographers, jury commissioners, law clerks, and other employees necessary to conduct the business of the court. 14

### 15 (F) IF A CIRCUIT COURT CONTRACTS WITH A PRIVATE ENTITY FOR 16 STENOGRAPHY SERVICES, THE COURT SHALL REQUIRE THE ENTITY TO PROVIDE 17 AT LEAST 5% OF THE STENOGRAPHY SERVICES FREE OF CHARGE IN ORDER TO 18 ENSURE ACCESS TO COURT SERVICES BY INDIGENT CLIENTS.
