A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Highway Work Zones – Off-Duty Law Enforcement Officers**
3 **Required**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to require a
5 contractor or other person that requires a work zone to be established on a
6 highway to retain, under certain circumstances, an off-duty law enforcement
7 officer to perform certain services in the work zone; defining certain terms; and
8 generally relating to the employment of off-duty law enforcement officers in
9 highway work zones.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Transportation**

18 **8–602.2.**

19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
20 MEANINGS INDICATED.

21 (2) “LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN
22 § 3–101 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **(3) “WORK ZONE” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 21-810 OF**
2 **THIS TITLE.**

3 **(B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REQUIRE A CONTRACTOR OR OTHER**
4 **PERSON THAT REQUIRES A WORK ZONE TO BE ESTABLISHED ON A HIGHWAY TO**
5 **RETAIN THE SERVICES OF AN OFF-DUTY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO**
6 **MONITOR AND ASSIST IN TRAFFIC CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT IN THE WORK**
7 **ZONE WHENEVER:**

8 **(1) WORKERS ARE PRESENT;**

9 **(2) ONE OR MORE OF THE TRAVEL LANES OF THE HIGHWAY ARE**
10 **CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC; AND**

11 **(3) THE SPEED LIMIT ON THE HIGHWAY THROUGH THE WORK**
12 **ZONE IS 40 MILES PER HOUR OR HIGHER.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2014.
