1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Transfer of Beer, Wine or**
3 **Liquor Licenses – Repeal of Prohibition**

4 **PG 301-14**

5 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain provision of law that prohibits the Prince
6 George's County Board of License Commissioners from transferring certain
7 beer, wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege into the boundaries
8 of certain alcoholic beverages districts; repealing a certain provision of law that
9 authorizes the Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners to
10 approve the transfer of a certain license into a certain alcoholic beverages
11 district provided any off-sale privileges of the license are permanently waived
12 as long as the license remains within the boundaries of a certain district; and
13 generally relating to the transfer of beer, wine or liquor licenses into alcoholic
14 beverages districts in Prince George's County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 9–217.

3 (l) (1) The Board of License Commissioners may not issue any new beer,
4 wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege within[, or transfer any
5 additional beer, wine or liquor licenses that have an off-sale privilege into] the
6 boundaries of the 21st (that part located within the county), 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th,
7 26th, 27th (that part located within the county), or 47th alcoholic beverages district as
8 follows:

9 (i) The 21st alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
10 coterminous with the Prince George’s County part of the 21st legislative district. As
11 ordered by the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the Prince George’s
12 County part of the 21st alcoholic beverages district consists of:

- 13 1. Prince George’s County election district 1;
- 14 2. Prince George’s County election district 10, precincts
15 1 through 5, 9, 12, and 13;
- 16 3. Prince George’s County election district 21, precincts
17 1, 2, 4, 14, 15, and 17;
- 18 4. That part of Prince George’s County election district
19 21, precinct 5 consisting of census tract 8073.05, block 1014; and
- 20 5. That part of Prince George’s County election district
21 21, precinct 10 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:
 - 22 A. Census tract 8067.03, blocks 1010, 1011, and 1014;
 - 23 B. Census tract 8069.00, blocks 1000 through 1019 and
24 3000 through 3021;
 - 25 C. Census tract 8070.00, blocks 1000 through 1025; and
 - 26 D. Census tract 8074.08, blocks 4015 and 4016;

27 (ii) The 22nd alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
28 coterminous with the 22nd legislative district in Prince George’s County. As ordered
29 by the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 22nd alcoholic beverages
30 district consists of:

2 (iii) The 23rd alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
3 coterminous with the 23rd legislative district in Prince George's County. As ordered by
4 the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 23rd alcoholic beverages district
5 consists of:

6 1. Delegate district 23A (two member delegate district):

7 A. Prince George's County election district 7, precincts 1
8 through 5;

9 B. Prince George's County election district 10, precincts
10 6 through 8, 10, and 11;

11 C. Prince George's County election district 14, precincts
12 1 through 7, 9, and 10;

13 D. Prince George's County election district 20, precincts
14 9 and 10; and

15 E. That part of Prince George's County election district
16 20, precinct 5 consisting of census tract 8004.08, blocks 2013, 2020, 2021, and 2022;
17 census tract 8036.07, blocks 3009 through 3011; and census tract 8036.08, blocks 1000
18 through 1002, 1005 through 1009, 1011 through 1015, 2000 through 2006, and 2008
19 through 2010; and

20 2. Delegate district 23B (single member delegate
21 district):

25 through 11;

26 (iv) The 24th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
27 coterminous with the 24th legislative district in Prince George's County. As ordered by
28 the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 24th alcoholic beverages district
29 consists of:

30 1. Prince George's County election district 6, precincts 3,
31 6, 9, 12, 15, and 19;

32 2. Prince George's County election district 13, precincts
33 1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 10, and 14 through 17;

1 3. Prince George's County election district 18, precincts
2 1 through 4 and 7 through 11;

3 4. Prince George's County election district 20, precincts
4 4 and 8;

5 5. That part of Prince George's County election district
6 18, precinct 5 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:

7 A. Census tract 8031.00, blocks 1003 through 1015,
8 1021, 1022, 1024 through 1029, and 2000 through 2017; and

9 B. Census tract 8033.00, blocks 3006 and 3008; and

10 6. That part of Prince George's County election district
11 18, precinct 6 consisting of census tract 8028.04, blocks 4005 and 4006;

12 (v) The 25th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
13 coterminous with the 25th legislative district in Prince George's County. As ordered by
14 the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 25th alcoholic beverages district
15 consists of:

16 1. Prince George's County election district 3, precinct 4;

17 2. Prince George's County election district 6, precincts 1,
18 4, 5, 7, 10, 11, 14, 16, 18, and 20 through 23;

19 3. Prince George's County election district 7, precinct 12;

20 4. Prince George's County election district 9, precincts 1,
21 3, 10, and 11;

22 5. Prince George's County election district 13, precincts
23 4, 6, 9, and 11 through 13;

24 6. Prince George's County election district 15, precinct 2;
25 and

26 7. That part of Prince George's County election district
27 18, precinct 6 consisting of census tract 8028.04, blocks 1006 through 1009, 2000
28 through 2003, 3000 through 3021, 4000, and 4002 through 4004;

29 (vi) The 26th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
30 coterminous with the 26th legislative district in Prince George's County. As ordered by
31 the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 26th alcoholic beverages district
32 consists of:

- 1 1. Prince George's County election district 12;
- 2 2. Prince George's County election district 5, precincts 2,
3 3, and 5 through 7;
- 4 3. Prince George's County election district 6, precincts 2,
5 8, 13, and 17; and
- 6 4. Prince George's County election district 9, precincts 2
7 and 5;

8 (vii) The 27th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
9 coterminous with the Prince George's County part of the 27th legislative district. As
10 ordered by the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the Prince George's
11 County part of the 21st alcoholic beverages district was in delegate district 27A (two
12 member delegate district) and consists of:

- 13 1. Prince George's County election districts 4, 8, and 11;
- 14 2. Prince George's County election district 3, precinct 1;
- 15 3. Prince George's County election district 5, precincts 1,
16 4, and 8;
- 17 4. Prince George's County election district 9, precincts 4
18 and 6 through 9; and
- 19 5. Prince George's County election district 15, precincts
20 1, 3, and 4; and

21 (viii) The 47th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be
22 coterminous with the 47th legislative district in Prince George's County. As ordered by
23 the Maryland Court of Appeals on June 21, 2002, the 47th alcoholic beverages district
24 consists of:

- 25 1. Prince George's County election district 2, precincts 1
26 through 4, 7, and 9;
- 27 2. Prince George's County election district 13, precinct 2;
- 28 3. Prince George's County election district 17, precincts
29 1 through 8, 10, 11, 13, and 14;
- 30 4. Prince George's County election district 20, precinct 3;
- 31 5. That part of Prince George's County election district
32 2, precinct 5 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:

1 A. Census tract 8040.01, block 2000; and

2 B. Census tract 8040.02, block 2003; and

3 6. That part of Prince George's County election district
4 2, precinct 8 consisting of the following census tracts and blocks:

5 A. Census tract 8039.00, blocks 3016 and 3017;

6 B. Census tract 8040.01, blocks 1000 through 1006,
7 2003, and 2004;

8 C. Census tract 8040.02, blocks 1000, 1001, 1002, 1004
9 through 1009, 1011 through 1017, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2009 through 2034, 2040, 2047,
10 2048, 2994, 2996, 2997, 2998, and 2999;

11 D. Census tract 8043.00, blocks 1000 through 1005,
12 1011, and 1014 through 1018;

13 E. That part of Prince George's County election district
14 16, precinct 1 consisting of census tract 8040.02, block 2008;

15 F. That part of Prince George's County election district
16 18, precinct 5 consisting of census tract 8031.00, blocks 1000, 1001, 1002, 1016
17 through 1020, and 1023; and census tract 8033.00, block 3007;

18 G. That part of Prince George's County election district
19 20, precinct 5 consisting of census tract 8036.01, blocks 1001 through 1005; and census
20 tract 8036.08, blocks 1003, 1004, 1010, 2007, 3000 through 3005, 4000, and 4002
21 through 4011; and

22 H. That part of Prince George's County election district
23 21, precinct 5 consisting of census tract 8073.01, block 1001; and census tract 8073.05,
24 blocks 1002 through 1013, 2001 through 2009, and 2011 through 2014.

25 (2) The Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners may
26 approve the issuance [or transfer] of a license into the boundaries of the 21st (that
27 part located within the county), 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th (that part located
28 within the county), or 47th alcoholic beverages district provided any off-sale privileges
29 of the license are permanently waived as long as the license remains within the
30 boundaries of the district.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
32 July 1, 2014.
