5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Prince George's County Board of Education from
6 issuing a credit card to a member of the county board; providing for a delayed
7 effective date; and generally relating to the members of the Prince George's
8 County Board of Education.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 3–1003.

18 (a) (1) From and after December 4, 2006, at the beginning of each
19 member's full term, the chair of the county board is entitled to receive \$19,000
20 annually as compensation and the other elected and appointed members are each
21 entitled to receive \$18,000 annually as compensation.

22 (2) Each elected and appointed member of the county board may be
23 provided health insurance and other fringe benefits regularly provided to employees of

1 the Board of Education under the same terms and conditions extended to other
2 employees of the Board of Education.

3 (b) (1) After submitting vouchers under the rules and regulations adopted
4 by the county board, the chair and the other members, including the student member,
5 are entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided in the Prince
6 George's County budget.

7 (2) A member of the county board may not be reimbursed more than
8 \$7,000 in travel and other expenses incurred in a single fiscal year.

9 (c) **THE COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE A CREDIT CARD TO A MEMBER**
10 **OF THE COUNTY BOARD.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 July 1, 2015.
