BY adding to Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 7–407 Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - State Finance and Procurement**
