4 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination date of certain provisions relating to the
5 Public School Labor Relations Board; requiring the Board to report to the
6 General Assembly on certain information and certain recommendations on or
7 before a certain date; and generally relating to the Public School Labor
8 Relations Board.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Chapter 325 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2010
11 Section 6

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 Chapter 325 of the Acts of 2010

15 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 July 1, 2010. [It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June
17 30, 2015, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
18 abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before August 1,
2 2018, the Public School Labor Relations Board, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the
3 State Government Article, shall report to the General Assembly on:

4 (1) for the period of July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2018:

5 (i) the number and type of cases heard by the Board;

6 (ii) the disposition of the cases decided by the Board;

7 (iii) the dates on which the cases were heard; and

8 (iv) the cost of fully processing the cases;

9 (2) trend data for each item listed in item (1) of this section between
10 July 1, 2014, and June 30, 2018; and

11 (3) any recommended legislation.

12 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
13 effect October 1, 2014.
