(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "ORGAN" INCLUDES A HUMAN KIDNEY, LIVER, HEART, LUNG, PANCREAS, CORNEA, EYE, OR BONE, AND HUMAN SKIN OR BONE MARROW OR A SUBPART OF THE ORGAN.

1 (1) RECRUIT, TRANSPORT, TRANSFER, HARBOR, OR RECEIVE AN 2 INDIVIDUAL, EITHER LIVING OR DECEASED, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMOVING 3 ONE OR MORE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S ORGANS, BY MEANS OF:

(I) COERCION;
(II) ABDUCTION;
(III) DECEPTION;
(IV) ABUSE OF POWER OR A POSITION OF VULNERABILITY;
OR
(V) TRANSFER OF PAYMENTS OR BENEFITS TO ACHIEVE THE
CONSENT OF A PERSON HAVING CONTROL OVER THE INDIVIDUAL; OR
(2) TRANSPORT OR TRANSPLANT AN ORGAN OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO ONE OR MORE OTHER PERSONS
FOR PROFIT OR FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE.
(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT
EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

18 October 1, 2014.
