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## Higher Education – 2+2 Transfer Scholarship

3 FOR the purpose of renaming the Community College Transfer Scholarship to be the 2+2 Transfer Scholarship and altering certain elements of the scholarship 4 program; altering the institutions at which the scholarship may be used,  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 qualifications for the scholarship, and the annual amount of the award; 7specifying that the scholarship may be used for a certain period of time; altering 8 the requirements for maintaining the award; repealing a certain employment 9 obligation associated with the scholarship; requiring certain funds to be transferred from a certain fund for certain purposes under 10 certain circumstances; and generally relating to the 2+2 Transfer Scholarship. 11
