## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Maryland Health Benefit Exchange - Criminal History Records Checks

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange to request from 4 the Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository a State and 5 national criminal history records check for certain individuals; requiring the 6 Exchange to submit fingerprints and certain fees to apply for a certain criminal 7 history records check; requiring the Central Repository to forward certain 8 criminal history record information to a certain individual and the Exchange; 9 providing that certain information is confidential and may be used only for certain purposes; authorizing certain individuals to contest the contents of a 10 certain statement; defining certain terms; and generally relating to criminal 11 12 history records checks and the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18
- MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 19

- 22 **(1)** (A) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 23 MEANINGS INDICATED.



- 1 (2) "ASSISTER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED OR ENGAGED
  2 BY AN INDIVIDUAL EXCHANGE CONNECTOR ENTITY WHO IS AUTHORIZED BY
  3 THE EXCHANGE TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES UNDER § 31–113(D) OF THIS TITLE.
- 4 (3) "CENTRAL REPOSITORY" MEANS THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE 5 INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF 6 PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.
- 7 (B) THE EXCHANGE SHALL REQUEST A STATE AND NATIONAL 8 CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK FROM THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY FOR 9 ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO PROVIDES OR MAY PROVIDE SERVICES AS AN ASSISTER, 10 AN APPLICATION COUNSELOR, A CONSOLIDATED SERVICES CENTER 11 EMPLOYEE, OR AN INDIVIDUAL EXCHANGE NAVIGATOR.
- 12 (C) AS PART OF THE APPLICATION FOR A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS
  13 CHECK REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE EXCHANGE
  14 SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY:
- 15 (1) TWO COMPLETE SETS OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S LEGIBLE
  16 FINGERPRINTS TAKEN ON FORMS APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE
  17 CENTRAL REPOSITORY AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF
  18 INVESTIGATION;
- 19 (2) THE FEE AUTHORIZED UNDER § 10–221(B)(7) OF THE 20 CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE FOR ACCESS TO STATE CRIMINAL HISTORY 21 RECORDS; AND
- 22 (3) THE PROCESSING FEE REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL BUREAU 23 OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK.
- 24 (D) IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE, THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL FORWARD TO THE INDIVIDUAL AND THE EXCHANGE THE INDIVIDUAL'S CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION.
- 28 (E) INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY UNDER 29 THIS SECTION:
- 30 (1) IS CONFIDENTIAL AND MAY NOT BE REDISSEMINATED; AND
- 31 **(2)** MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF EVALUATING 32 QUALIFICATIONS OF INDIVIDUALS WHO PROVIDE OR MAY PROVIDE SERVICES AS

- 1 AN ASSISTER, AN APPLICATION COUNSELOR, A CONSOLIDATED SERVICES 2 CENTER EMPLOYEE, OR AN INDIVIDUAL EXCHANGE NAVIGATOR.
- (F) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF A CRIMINAL HISTORY
  RECORDS CHECK UNDER THIS SECTION MAY CONTEST THE CONTENTS OF THE
  PRINTED STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY AS PROVIDED IN §
  10–223 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2014.
