# 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Election Law

#### 16 (a) To sign a petition, an individual shall ENTER THE FOLLOWING 17 INFORMATION IN THE SPACES PROVIDED:

- 18 (1) [sign] the [individual's] SIGNER'S name, PRINTED OR TYPED, as 19 it appears on the statewide voter registration list or the [individual's] SIGNER'S 20 surname of registration and at least one full given name and the initials of any other 21 names; [and
- (2) include the following information, printed or typed, in the spacesprovided:
  - EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

13		(3)	the individu	al has not previously signed the same petition;

$27 \\ 28 \\ 29$	(2) A signature removed pursuant to paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection may not be included in the number of signatures stated on the information page included in the petition.
