A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008 – Baltimore County –**
3 **The Emmart–Pierpoint Safe House**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008
5 to alter the purpose for which a certain grant may be used; making this Act an
6 emergency measure; and generally relating to amending the Maryland
7 Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 **RECONSTRUCTION,** renovation, **RESTORATION,** and capital
24 equipping of the [Emmart–Pierpoint Safe House,] **CHERRY**

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
4 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
5 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
6 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
7 the date it is enacted.
