### 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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### Article – Public Utilities

14 **7–302.1**.

15(A) IN THIS SECTION, "SMART METER" MEANS A DIGITAL METER THAT16ALLOWS TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION BETWEEN AN ELECTRIC CUSTOMER'S17PREMISES AND AN ELECTRIC COMPANY THROUGH A WIRELESS NETWORK.

18(B) AN ELECTRIC COMPANY MAY NOT CHARGE A TENANT FOR THE19INSTALLATION OF A SMART METER ON RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PROPERTY20LEASED BY THE TENANT.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 June 1, 2014.
