12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

1 (1) be appointed, organized, and begin its deliberations no later than
2 September 1, 2013;

3 (2) submit ~~an~~ interim ~~report~~ reports of its findings and
4 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State
5 Government Article, the General Assembly, on or before December 31, ~~2013~~, AND
6 ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2014; and

7 (3) submit a final report of its findings and any recommendations for
8 legislation to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government
9 Article, the General Assembly, on or before December 1, ~~2014~~ **2015**.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 July 1, 2013. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] **2 YEARS** and 6 months
12 and, at the end of December 31, ~~2014~~ **2015**, with no further action required by the
13 General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2014.
