1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Newborn Screening Program**
3 **Fund – Establishment**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Newborn Screening Program Fund; requiring the
5 Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to administer the Fund; providing for
6 the uses, purposes, sources of funding, investment of money, and auditing of the
7 Fund; providing that the Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund not subject to
8 certain provisions of law; requiring the Secretary to pay certain fees to the
9 Comptroller; requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain fees to the Fund;
10 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the Newborn Screening
11 Program Fund in the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (F) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL PAY ALL FEES COLLECTED UNDER
4 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE TO THE COMPTROLLER.

5 (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE
6 ~~FUND~~ NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 13–113
7 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

8 13–113.

9 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “FUND” MEANS THE NEWBORN SCREENING
10 PROGRAM FUND.

11 (B) THERE IS A NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM FUND.

12 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE
13 SCREENING OF NEWBORN INFANTS IN THE STATE FOR CERTAIN HEREDITARY
14 AND CONGENITAL DISORDERS.

15 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

16 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT
17 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

18 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND
19 SEPARATELY, AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

20 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

21 (1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 13–111(F) OF
22 THIS SUBTITLE;

23 (2) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
24 AND

25 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED
26 FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

27 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO COVER THE ADMINISTRATIVE,
28 LABORATORY, AND FOLLOW–UP COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PERFORMANCE
29 OF NEWBORN SCREENING TESTS CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

1 **(H) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND**
2 **IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.**

3 **(I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN**
4 **ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.**

5 **(J) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND**
6 **TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1220 OF THE STATE**
7 **GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 ~~October~~ July 1, 2014.
