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- [(c)] (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, [a spouse or financially dependent child of an active duty member] AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION who enrolls as an entering student in a public institution of higher education [and] IN THE STATE is exempt from paying nonresident tuition [under subsection (b) of this section shall continue to be exempt from paying nonresident tuition if:
- 9 (1) The active duty member no longer meets the requirements of subsection (b)(1) of this section; and
- 11 (2) The spouse or financially dependent child remains continuously 12 enrolled at the public institution of higher education] AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF 13 HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE REGARDLESS OF WHERE THE ACTIVE DUTY 14 OR RETIRED MEMBER IS OR WAS STATIONED, RESIDES, OR IS DOMICILED.
- 15 **[(d)] (C)** The Commission shall adopt regulations in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article to implement the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
