20	(2)	Of the 15 members of the Commission:
21		(i) at least 2 shall be certified general real estate appraisers;

3 4	(iii) 2 shall be representatives of a financial institution who are not certified or licensed real estate appraisers or home inspectors;

7 8	(v) 1 shall be a licensed home inspector who is a member of the National Association of Home Inspectors;
