BY adding to Article – Transportation Section 21–314 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 21-314. IN THIS SECTION, "HOV LANE" MEANS A HIGH OCCUPANCY
