1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources – Recreational Incentives Pilot Program**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Recreational Incentives Pilot Program in the
4 Department of Natural Resources; stating the purpose of the pilot program;
5 requiring the Department to develop a plan to implement the pilot program,
6 subject to certain requirements and restrictions; requiring the Department to
7 administer the pilot program in accordance with the developed plan; requiring
8 the Department to report to the Governor and the General Assembly regarding
9 the operation and results of the pilot program on or before a certain date;
10 authorizing the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain
11 term; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the
12 establishment of and standards for the Recreational Incentives Pilot Program.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 SUBTITLE 9. RECREATIONAL INCENTIVES PILOT PROGRAM.

3 1–901.

4 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, “PILOT PROGRAM” MEANS THE RECREATIONAL
5 INCENTIVES PILOT PROGRAM.

6 (B) THERE IS A RECREATIONAL INCENTIVES PILOT PROGRAM IN THE
7 DEPARTMENT.

8 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PILOT PROGRAM IS TO DETERMINE WHETHER
9 INCENTIVE DISCOUNTS OFFERED TO INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE NOT PURCHASED
10 A RECREATIONAL FISHING OR HUNTING LICENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 3
11 YEARS INCREASE THE PURCHASE OF RECREATIONAL LICENSES ISSUED UNDER
12 §§ 4–604, 4–745, AND 10–301 OF THIS ARTICLE.

13 (D) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A PLAN TO IMPLEMENT
14 THE PILOT PROGRAM.

15 (2) THE PLAN TO IMPLEMENT THE PILOT PROGRAM SHALL:

16 (I) IDENTIFY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE INCENTIVE
17 DISCOUNTS;

18 (II) ESTABLISH AMOUNTS FOR THE INCENTIVE DISCOUNTS;
19 AND

20 (III) INCLUDE A MARKETING STRATEGY FOR ATTRACTING
21 ELIGIBLE RECREATIONAL LICENSE CUSTOMERS.

22 (3) UNDER THE PLAN, AN INCENTIVE DISCOUNT MAY NOT:

23 (I) EXCEED 50% OF THE UNDERLYING LICENSE FEE; OR

24 (II) BE OFFERED OR PROVIDED FOR A SPECIFIC
25 RECREATIONAL LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS HELD THAT LICENSE
26 WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 3 YEARS.

27 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE PILOT PROGRAM IN
28 ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLAN DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS
29 SECTION.

1 **(F) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL**
2 **REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE**
3 **STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE OPERATION**
4 **AND RESULTS OF THE PILOT PROGRAM.**

5 **(G) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS**
6 **SECTION.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2014. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of
9 September 30, 2017, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
10 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
