1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Stationary Engineers – Sunset Extension and Program**
3 **Evaluation**

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Stationary Engineers in accordance
5 with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by
6 extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and
7 regulatory authority of the Board; requiring that a preliminary evaluation of the
8 Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be conducted on or
9 before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Board of Stationary
10 Engineers.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

7 6.5–502.

8 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland
9 Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall
10 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2014] **2024**.

11 **Article – State Government**

12 8–403.

13 (a) On or before December 15 of the evaluation year specified, the
14 Department shall:

15 (1) conduct a preliminary evaluation of each governmental activity or
16 unit to be evaluated under this section; and

17 (2) prepare a report on each preliminary evaluation conducted.

18 (b) Each of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes
19 and regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units are subject to
20 preliminary evaluation in the evaluation year specified:

21 (18) Engineers, State Board of Stationary (§ 6.5–201 of the Business
22 Occupations and Professions Article: [2011] **2021**);

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 July 1, 2014.
