1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Nursing – Electrology Practice Committee – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Electrology Practice Committee
4 within the State Board of Nursing; providing for the elimination of the positions
5 of certain members of the Committee; and generally relating to the membership
6 of the Electrology Practice Committee within the State Board of Nursing.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Health Occupations**

20 8–6B–05.

- 1 (a) There is an Electrology Practice Committee within the Board.
- 2 (b) (1) The Committee consists of [~~five~~] **THREE** members appointed by
3 the Board.
- 4 (2) Of the [~~five~~] **THREE** Committee members:
- 5 (i) [~~Four~~] **TWO** shall be licensed electrologists or licensed
6 electrology instructors; and
- 7 (ii) One shall be a consumer member.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, to implement the
9 reduction in the number of members of the Electrology Practice Committee from five
10 to three as provided in § 8-6B-05(b) of the Health Occupations Article, as enacted by
11 Section 1 of this Act, the positions of the two licensed electrologist or licensed
12 electrology instructor members of the Committee whose second terms expired in June
13 2011 and June 2013 shall be eliminated on the effective date of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 July 1, 2014.
