## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Unlicensed Establishments –**  
3 **Prohibitions**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an establishment in Calvert County that is not  
5 licensed by the Board of License Commissioners from giving, serving,  
6 dispensing, keeping, or allowing to be consumed on its premises, or on premises  
7 under its control or possession, any alcoholic beverages; establishing a certain  
8 penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages  
9 in Calvert County.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
22 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 20–103.1 of Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages of the  
23 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 20–103.2.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland  
25 read as follows:

2 (A) **THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CALVERT COUNTY.**

3 (B) **AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS NOT LICENSED BY THE BOARD OF**  
4 **LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY NOT GIVE, SERVE, DISPENSE, KEEP, OR ALLOW**  
5 **TO BE CONSUMED ON ITS PREMISES, OR ON PREMISES UNDER ITS CONTROL OR**  
6 **POSSESSION, ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

7 (C) **A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A**  
8 **MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING**  
9 **\$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS OR BOTH.**

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 July 1, 2014.
