14 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 October 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of [8] 13 years and, at the end of 16 September 30, [2014] 2019, with no further action required by the General Assembly, 17 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect19 July 1, 2014.
